Saturday 12th May - Coalville Churches Praying Together are meeting at St Christopher's, Ellistown, from 9.00am till 10.00am to pray for our area - followed by refreshments.

Sunday 13th May - Afternoon Tea at St John Baptist Hugglescote from 3.00pm. Proceeds in aid of Christian Aid. Leave a prayer

Tuesday 15th May - Prayer in the Lady Chapel of St John Baptist Hugglescote from 6.00pm to 7.00pm.

Thursday 10th to Sunday 20th May - St Mary's Snibston will be open all week for quiet prayer.

Thursday 17th May and Sunday 20th May - Mindfulness Walks at 2pm. Make some space to get in touch with yourself, and with the natural world. A quiet, gentle guided walk around the recreation area and woodlands taking time out to notice the sights and sounds of nature and reflect on life.

The circular walk lasts about an hour. Please wear suitable shoes for walking and bring a rain coat and drink if necessary. Meet Rev. Sarah Fegredo at the entrance gate to the Recreation ground on Ashburton Rd.

Thursday 10th May and Thursday 17th May - An Oasis of Prayer 11.30am-12noon in the upstairs room at the Oasis Café.

There will be prayer stations at each of the above Churches and in The Oasis on Central Road.

Hugglescote Prayer Walk

10th to 20th May 2018

Hugglescote Churches Together has put together this Prayer Walk as part of "Thy Kingdom Come". It can be a physical walk around the village, but if you are unable to do this, you can do the walk in your imagination. The aim of the walk is to seek God's blessing for those who live in Hugglescote.

"We can be confident that he will listen to us whenever we ask him for anything in line with his will. And if we know he is listening when we make our requests, we can be sure that he will give us what we ask for. (1 John 5:14-15)"

As you walk, focus on the needs of those living around you. Pray for each street, and those who live there. You can walk alone, but you may find the experience more exciting walking with a friend. You can pray silently or audibly as you walk. But remember, pray inconspicuously and quietly. As you walk and pray, you may become more aware of the spiritual climate in the village or get a feeling in your heart that a home or street needs special attention or intercession.

Guidelines to Prayer Walking

1. Prepare your heart before your walk.
2. Ask God to guide you and let you know His heart for His people.
3. Expect God to help you see the needs of those you pray for.
4. Walk and pray inconspicuously.
5. Keep safe! Walk against traffic.
6. Be sensitive to what God may say to you.
7. Pray that God's blessing will come to those you pray for.

Suggested Route

The route starts and ends at the Oasis. Feel free to use the upstairs Prayer Room for your preparation. You can of course start and finish at any point on the route, and miss parts out if you feel it would be too much for you. If you want to lengthen the route and pray for other streets, please do so.



The Oasis Before you leave the Oasis, pray for all the people that come in for coffee, food and fellowship. Pray for Deborah, the manager, and for all the volunteers who make the Oasis possible. Pray particularly for those who come to Renew 67, the Friday Afternoon “Wellbeing Café”.

On leaving the Oasis, turn left and walk until you reach the Hugglescote Bear.



The Bear The statue reminds us of the history of the village. Pray for those keeping this history alive through the Hugglescote Historical society. Pray that in God’s wisdom, we may learn lessons from the past and look forward with hope for the future.

From the Bear, walk down Fairfield Rd, until you reach the Gate Inn.



The Gate Inn The Gate Inn reminds us that people outside the Church also need to meet for companionship. Pray for those who gather here and in other similar places. That God will bless them and help them to know it is Him who can really meet their needs.

Cross Ashburton Rd to Hugglescote Community Primary School.



Hugglescote Community Primary School Pray for the children that they might grow up having a desire to know God in their lives. Pray for their teachers, that they might help them to learn and help them in their character development. Pray for the Churches Together “Open the Book” team, that they speak clearly about Jesus.

Continue to the right of the school until you reach the recreation field.



Recreation Fields and Playground Pray that God will bless those who come here to relax and play. The children playing games, the adults walking their dogs and those just enjoying the open spaces. Pray that God might help us all to relax, and find time to unwind from our busy lives.

Retrace your steps past the School until you reach the crossroads. Cross over to the Hugglescote Community Centre.



Hugglescote Community Centre Pray for all the groups that meet here every week. Slimming clubs, Church Lads / girls brigade, fitness and special interest groups. Pray for the Hugglescote Parish Council, that God will guide them and give them wisdom. Pray also for Hugglescote Community Church that meets here each Sunday.

Carry on along Grange Road until you reach St John the Baptist Parish Church



St John the Baptist Parish Church Pray for the Church and for those who come to the church for baptisms, weddings and funerals. Pray also for those who lead and those who attend. Pray that God will bless them and help them, together with the members of the Hugglescote Community Church, to be his light in the village.

Carry on along Grange Rd until you reach the new development on your right.



Hastings Manor Pray for those moving into the village, here, and in the other new building developments. Pray that God will help them feel at home, and find friends in the community. Pray that those who already live here will make them feel welcome.

Carry on to the Doctors surgery on your left.



Doctors Surgery Pray for God’s blessing on the nurses and doctors who work in the village. Pray for all who are sick, and need God’s blessing in an extra special way.

Retrace your steps heading back towards the parish church until you reach the Baptist graveyard



Baptist Graveyard Pray for all who mourn the loss of loved ones, that they might know God’s peace and reassurance. Pray particularly for anyone recently bereaved and for their friends and families.

Head back past the Church. Turn right at the Crossroads and return to the Oasis.
