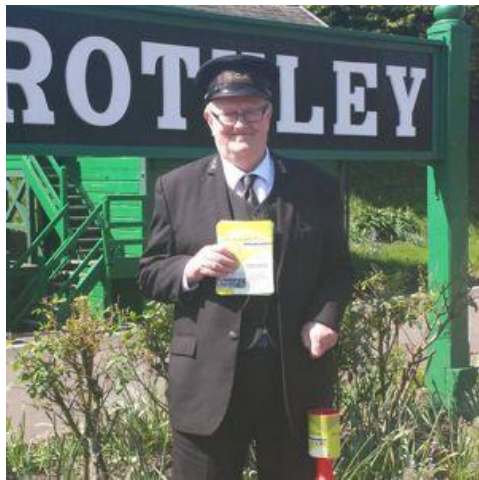
St John Baptist, Hugglescote

This has been a sad month for our parish. Three regular members of our congregations passed away. Betty Hornbuckle was born and brought up on Highfield Street and attended St James and St Mary's until she became too frail to do so. Sadly, Betty spent her last few years being cared for in residential homes. Those who knew her remember her with fondness.

Then last week we held the funeral of John Price who died suddenly after a short illness. John had little close family but the church was full, his friends, neighbours and his colleagues from the preserved railway turned out in force. I thought you would like to see this tribute to him in Grand Central Railway's Rail Mail.
